Purpose:

We are encouraging you to memorize Scripture and apply it to your life. This year the format is an inductive study guide. This method can be used to study any passage in the Bible. It is a valuable tool which you will be able to use the rest of your life.

Important Dates to Remember:

Registration for camp should be done by April 1st. Verses must be completed by June 4th.

1. You will be assigned to an adult hearer, who will listen to you quote verses and check your answers. The questions in each lesson must be completed prior to reciting the verses.
2. **You may use the translation with which you are most comfortable. Please bring your Bible for your listener to follow as you recite the passages.** You must quote the entire lesson at one time.
3. You must recite the references and each verse word-for-word.
4. You may only do one lesson per week.
5. The adult hearer must sign and date the bottom of each lesson as it is completed.
6. Turn in your completed book to the church office.
